Serminaz Barseghian is an Iranian-Armenian artist, working predominantly in painting and drawing. Her works offer a space of fantasy, where she explores methods of spatial representation in image making with specific attention towards habituality in social and material spaces. Her felt-tip drawings render familiar spaces into a composition of lines and curves. Through her meticulous depiction, she challenges the notions of accuracy and permanency, of what perhaps is and what will be down the line, emphasizing the uncertainty of images and fixed reality.
