Aylar Dastgiri is a Tehran-based artist working primarily in painting, drawing, sculpture and printmaking. Dastgiri's work is characterized by an exploration into the diverse layers which compose our environment, bodies, and minds, and how these layers are represented in visual art. Her use of color, contrast, perspective and layering of picture elements creates entrancing imagery and spatial illusions that reference theatrical staging and attempt to place her viewers in the middle of her works. Dastgiri's still lifes and landscapes are created from memory, also lending them a dream-like quality.
